- Ensure when opening and closing your Clothes Airer that your hands are positioned where they will provide support and will not be caught in moving parts.
- Inspect regularly do not use if damaged.






Step 1 – Assembling the Fixed Frame

- **1.1** Push one of the Fixed Frames into the fixed part of the central Pivot until it locks into position. (**Fig. 2**).
- **1.2** Repeat again with the second Pivot at the base of the frame.




Step 2 – Assembling the Pivoting Frame

2.1 Fix one of the Clothes Hanger Hooks to one of the Pivoting Frames as shown using two of the small screws. (**Fig. 3**). Repeat for the second Pivoting Frame.



2.2 Push one of the Pivoting Frames into the pivoting part of the central Pivot, until it locks into position. (**Fig. 4**). Repeat again at the base of the frame with the second Pivot.




 Push the Pivoting Frame into the Locking Clip on the Fixed Frame to stop it from rotating outward. (Fig. 5).


Note: Repeat these steps on the other side of the Pivot with the remaining frames. Fig. 5

Step 3 – Assembling the Wheels

3.1 Push a locking castor into each of the Pivoting Frame's feet. To do this, insert the metal pin of the castor into the hole in the base of the foot and apply force until the castor clicks into position and cannot be removed. (**Fig. 6**).




3.2 Repeat on the Fixed Frames using the non-locking castors. (**Fig. 7**).




Step 4 – Assembling the Shelves


- **4.1** Bring the product to the upright position.
- 4.2 Disengage one of the Pivoting Frames from the Locking Clip and rotate outward90 degrees to keep it steady. (Fig. 8).





4.3 Place one of the shelves in between the two Fixed Frames at a 45 degree angle. (**Fig. 9**).





4.5 Repeat on the opposite side of the frame and for each remaining shelf. (**Fig. 11**).










Step 5 – Operating the Clothes Airer

5.1 Rotate both of the Pivoting Frames outward and lock the wheels by pulling the lever in the up position. (**Fig. 12**).




- **5.2** Rotate one of the shelves upward and clip it into the corresponding clip on the Pivot Frame. (**Fig. 13**).
- **5.3** Repeat for each of the other shelves. (**Fig. 14**).



Step 6 – Using the Clothes Hanger Hooks

- **6.1** Unclip the top shelf and fold down 90 degrees. If you have purchased a Hills 3-Tier Clothes Airer you may need to fold down a second shelf on one side.
- **6.2** Hang the clothes hanger in the indented part of the hanger hook at the top of the Pivoting Frame. (**Fig. 15**).




Note: If unclipping the lowest shelf, ensure to have the other side engaged or to lock the castor on the pivoting frame.


Lock all the locking castors to reduce the risk of the product moving when loaded.

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Step 7 – Folding the Clothes Airer against a wall

- **7.1** To stand the Clothes Airer against a wall, unclip all the shelves on one side of the frame and rotate down 90 degrees.
- 7.2 Secure the Pivoting Frame into the locking clip. (Fig. 16).






Step 8 – Storing the Clothes Airer

8.1 To fold the Clothes Airer completely for storage, unclip and fold down the shelves on both sides and clip the Pivoting Frames into the Locking Clips on both sides of the product. (**Fig. 17**).

Note: Lay the product flat if required.



3-Year Warranty*

*In addition to other rights and remedies that may be available under any applicable law, Cyclone Tools Pty Ltd warrants to the purchaser of the product (customer) that this product will be free from defects in workmanship and materials for 3 years from the date of purchase of the product.
